Legislative Report  
May 27, 2016

The Senate is moving quickly to arrive at their version of this year's State budget bill. There is plenty of discussion around the legislature and from Senate leadership that the Senate will be releasing their version of the State budget bill next week or shortly thereafter. The consensus still seems to be that the legislature is on a fast track to get the budget resolved and to adjourn the session sometime in late June or early July. This was an active week at the General Assembly, with the House considering and approving a bill that would modify the State's current plan to address coal ash, and the Senate considering and passing out of committee the Regulatory Reduction Act of 2016.

The House did not hold committee meetings on Thursday and has scheduled "no vote sessions" on Friday and next Monday to allow House members to have a long Memorial Day weekend. The Senate held committee meetings on Thursday, and has also scheduled no votes on Friday or next Monday.

The House and Senate both adjourned this week to reconvene next Tuesday.
